



BEFORE RETURNING TO WORK

(Louis Brier & Weinberg Residence)

1. If you have traveled **to** or **through** these places in the last 14 days (**China, Hong Kong, Korea, Italy, Iran, Japan, Germany, Spain, France, Diamond Princess cruise, and Washington and California States USA**); **OR**
2. If you have been in close contact with someone who has recently visited China; **OR**
3. If you have been in contact with someone who has been tested positive for Coronavirus
4. If you have visited or worked in Lynn Valley Care Centre, North Vancouver, for the last 14 days

Before returning to work, please call Lunadel Daclan (Tel. 604-267-4698) or Loren Tisdelle (Tel. 604-267-4704), even if you are NOT experiencing any flu-like symptoms. If we are not in our office at the time of your call, please leave a message and we'll get back to you as soon as we can.

If you are sick, do NOT come to work! Follow our sick leave policy and procedure.

Consistent with our Mission to provide exemplary resident and family-centred care for seniors, we are committed to enhancing the health and safety of everyone in the campus. We have to be extra vigilant because we are taking care of a vulnerable population in Louis Brier and Weinberg Residence.
