D. Executive Update (PART 1)

a. COVID Update

LBHH on "enhanced surveillance" due to 2 non residents who contracted COVID. No outbreak otherwise in LBHH.

b. Points of clarification in visiting residents:

- Residents do not need to wear a mask when leaving the building or their room.

- All visitors must be wearing a mask at all times around all residents

- **Taking a resident out of LBHH:** inform the nursing station and the visitation assistant at the front when you sign in. There is no special form. The nursing team just need to know so they can inform their care staff and hold meal trays if needed.

- There is no specific criteria for taking a resident out.

- **Consider if what the resident is wearing** is appropriate **and if they have had their medication** for the time they will be out of the building.
